SUBJECT: 2011 Professional Ethics and Conduct Webcast

The North Carolina Association of CPAs (NCACPA) will offer a webcast, *2011 Professional Ethics and Conduct*, exclusively for State government on May 26, 2011 from 2 pm to 3:40 pm. The registration fee for this webcast is **\$35 per attendee** (payable to NCACPA).

Registering for this webcast will be a two-step process as follows:

- First, attendees will need to pre-register with the Office of the State Controller (OSC) by clicking on the “Training” link at the top of the OSC web page (<http://www.osc.nc.gov>). The deadline for pre-registering with OSC is May 5, 2011 (Note: Payment should not be made at this time).
- Secondly, pre-registered attendees will receive an email invitation from NCACPA to formally register for this webcast on May 9, 2011. The email from NCACPA will provide registration and payment options. (Note: You must formally register with NCACPA to participate). NCACPA accepts payment by credit card (MasterCard, Visa, and American Express) and by check (payable to NCACPA).

This course fulfills the State CPA Board’s annual two-hour Ethics CPE requirement [NCAC 8G.0410 *Professional Ethics and Conduct CPE*]. The instructor is Cal Christian, CPA, PhD, an Associate Professor of Accounting at East Carolina University. Cal has more than 10 years of experience in both the public accounting profession and in industry. Cal has his PhD from Florida State University and his BA from the University of Mississippi. In addition to teaching continuing education courses for NCACPA, Cal also teaches and writes courses for the AICPA, CPA firms and publicly traded companies and has been recognized as a NCACPA Outstanding Discussion Leader.
