
RALEIGH – For Fiscal Year 2013, when compared to the prior year through May 31, North Carolina experienced an increase in General Fund receipts which include tax and non-tax receipts. Tax revenues increased by \$890.2 million, or 5.4 percent, and non-tax revenues decreased by \$42.3 million, or 4.5 percent as compared to the previous year.

The General Fund’s unreserved fund balance as of May 2013 was \$496.1 million as compared to \$449.4 million as of May 2012.
