PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE OF THE STATEWIDE PORTAL COMMITTEE

RALEIGH – State Controller David McCoy today announced that the first meeting of the Statewide Portal Committee will be held at **10 a.m. on Wednesday, Sept. 12 in the Office of State Controller Banner Elk Conference Room, 3514 Bush Street in Raleigh.** Items on the agenda include: a history of the portal project, new transactional functionality including eForms and digital signatures, as well as next steps.

The General Assembly, in Section 6A.12(h) of H.950, established the Statewide Portal Committee consisting of seven members: two members appointed by the Governor, two members appointed by the Speaker of the House, two members appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate, and the State Controller who serves as Chairman.

The State Controller is North Carolina's chief fiscal officer. The Office of the State Controller serves as an independent resource to ensure the financial integrity of the State by providing accounting, disbursing, payroll, internal control and financial reporting systems that serve state agencies, employees and the public and maximizing financial return through its statewide cash management plan. The OSC issues numerous financial reports including: General Fund Monthly Financial Report, IT Expenditures Report, Statewide Accounts Receivable Report, the State's Comprehensive Annual Financial Report (CAFR) as well as the short, easy-to-read version of the CAFR known as the "popular" report.
